Hospitals and local area health centres are primary touchpoints where the vast population of India receives the health and medical support. While there is dearth of such good set ups in our country that can provide quality of healthcare support at reasonable or subsidised cost, however building such centres and hospitals grounds up is a major project and requires significant funds, time, and dedicated team of specialised health care professionals.

At the same time there are many such centres and hospitals that are operated by dedicated and experienced medical professionals, primarily offering their services to needy population at a nominal or zero cost. However, such set ups (which are mostly operated by charitable trusts)
